

DECORATIVE VALUE OF THE BUILT-IN FURNITURE IN BEROVO MONASTERY FACILITY FROM THE BEGINNING OF THE XIX CENTURY

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ABSTRACT

This paper covers a research of the architectural features and values of traditional furniture decoration in Maleshevo region of Macedonia. The subject of the research is the furniture in the Monastery facility in Berovo from the beginning of the XIX century.

The goal of the research is to analyze and appraise the values of furniture decoration that are not sufficiently explored and preserved in this region. The research is focused on two issues: the typology and decorative value of the furniture in questions, as well as the anthropological development of its users, Macedonian women tied directly to that architecture and culture, living in the vicinity of the Monastery facilities.

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
